*New employees will receive 80% of the patrol officer rate of \$33.46 an hour for the first six months, 85% after completion of six months, 90% after completion of one year, 95% after completion of 1½ years, and full patrol officer pay rate after 2 years. Applicants with at least three years full-time law enforcement experience may be started at 90% and receive full patrol officer rate after one year.
